

Highlights

The following events highlighted the second period of 2007 for Exhibition Islam.

Community Fair 2K7 Exhibition Islam in the Park

Exhibition Islam was once again at centre stage at the Community Fair 2K7 hosted in Mile End park in July 2007. The event attracted over 7,000 visitors and proved to be a great success. Exhibition Islam displayed in the Central Marquee and managed to safely stream through streams of the visiting public.

Exhibition Islam @ St. Georges Maritime Chatham Marine Time

Exhibition Islam had the exclusive privilege to be the first Islamic organisation to display an exhibition at the St. Georges Church in Chatham Maritime, Kent. The Muslim community hosted this event to dispel negative connotations charged at them by the media. The event was attended by local government and attracted thousands of visitors. In addition it received endorsement from all the civil institutions and received positive coverage in local media. In addition it generated a great deal of enthusiasm within the local Muslim community to open up to members of other cultural and religious faith groups.

Building Bridges – NOMS MCA

This event was organised by the Muslim Chaplains Association to inform the public more about their function as well as get other organisations onboard in serving inmates both in and outside of the prison environment. Exhibition Islam were invited to exhibit their displays and as a consequence have received a number of future invitations to impart information about the Islamic faith inside HM Prisons around the country.

Global Peace and Unity Excel (London)

The Global Peace and Unity event hosted at the London Excel formed the background to one of the busiest exhibitions for Exhibition Islam. Over a period of 2 days, Exhibition Islam hosted nearly 20,000 visitors.

In addition to this, the exhibition area situated at the heart of the venue dominated the event. Exhibition Islam put on display its rare and highly coveted Quran collection. In the backdrop, organisers displayed the Kiswah, the holy cloth from the Ka'aba.


Charity Status
